

Insights into Visitor Interactions

- **Ask about a *typical day* in their life**

- What is their daily routine at home or at school?
- What do they normally do for fun?
- What is their family like?
- Do they have photos of their home or their family?
- Use Internet to look up details about their country, home, town or area for discussions



- **Ask about their *hobbies*, and find resources for their interests in your area**

- Music is a universal language: If your visitor plays an instrument – play together, or go to a free concert
 - If your visitor plays a sport – play or see a game together
 - Play interactive games such as Wii



- **Be an *ambassador* of US culture**

- Go bowling, to a movie theater, or shopping at a local mall
- Introduce “seasonal” activities - BBQs, yard sales, carving pumpkins, ice skating



- **Invite your visitor to join you during your *daily routine***

- Go on errands together –grocery store, drug store, post office, ATM, bank, Starbuck’s, etc.
- Walk the dog, do laundry, or watch a favorite TV show together



- **Invite your visitor to go to on *outings and to events***

- Host a potluck dinner or child birthday party at your home
- Introduce your visitor to friends, family, neighbors, or others

- **Cook a meal together**

- Discuss differences in food, or portion sizes, meal times
- Have your visitor make a traditional dish from their home
